A Whisper of Ages: Seeking the Sacred at Stonehenge



The moment you see it; the breath catches in your throat. Not because of its size, but its impossible age, its profound mystery, and the way it seems to have grown out of the rolling green canvas of Salisbury Plain. Stonehenge is not just a monument; it's a whisper from 5,000 years ago, and to stand in its presence is to become a silent listener to history.

For centuries, this colossal circle of stones has been the ultimate question mark. Who were the people who managed to drag 25-ton sarsen stones from miles away, or the smaller bluestones all the way from Wales—an incredible feat of Neolithic engineering? Was it a temple, an astronomical calendar, a ceremonial healing center, or a place for the ancestral dead? The definitive answer remains just out of reach, and that enigma is the very heart of its allure.

For the typical visitor, the experience begins at the superb English Heritage Visitor Center, a short distance from the stones. From there, a shuttle bus or a scenic 20-minute walk across the expansive downland takes you to the circle.

Today, due to preservation concerns, a rope barrier maintains a respectful distance. You'll walk the perimeter, absorbing the monument from every angle. Yet, even from this remove, the stones are mesmerizing. Stand on the pathway, put on the complimentary audio guide, and you can practically feel the weight of time. Look toward the **Heel Stone**, where the sun perfectly aligns during the **Summer Solstice**, and the original purpose of this ancient clock becomes beautifully, chillingly clear.

Traveler's Tip: The summer high season is glorious but crowded. For a quieter, more atmospheric visit, aim for a weekday during the shoulder seasons (late spring or early autumn), and book your tickets for either the first or last entry time of the day to capture that dramatic, long-shadow light.



For the dedicated history buff or the spiritual seeker, there is a way to transcend the viewing rope and walk among the megaliths themselves: the **Stone Circle Experience**.

These special access tours, often booked weeks or months in advance, take place either early in the morning, before the site opens, or late in the evening, after it has closed to the general public. With a small, intimate group, you are escorted directly inside the sarsen and bluestone ring.

This is the moment of transcendence. Without the clamor of the crowds, the silence is broken only by the wind, and the stones tower over you, their rough, grey surfaces scarred by the ages. It's here, when you can reach out and almost touch the ancient stone, that the



theories—of Druids, of giant calendars, of forgotten rites—feel less like academic speculation and more like tangible memories. It's a profound, meditative experience that turns a great day trip into an unforgettable spiritual pilgrimage.

Don't make the mistake of leaving right after your circuit of the stones. The Stonehenge World Heritage Site is vast, encompassing 6,500 acres of archaeological treasures. Its exhibition houses fascinating artifacts, including a reconstructed face of a Neolithic man and detailed information on the origins of sarsen and bluestone.

Step into reconstructed Neolithic houses near the centre to get a tangible sense of how the monument's builders lived and worked over 4,500 years ago. Look out across the landscape to see the faint, mile-long earthwork known as the Cursus—another baffling Neolithic monument that runs parallel to the stones.

Stonehenge is more than just a pile of rocks; it is a monument to human ingenuity, resilience, and an unwavering connection to the cosmos. A trip here isn't just a tick off the bucket list—it's a journey to the very beginning of Britain's history, leaving you with a sense of wonder that lasts long after you've left the rolling plains of Wiltshire behind.



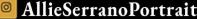

EG Simmons Park

E.G. Simmons Conservation Park, often referred to as E.G. Simmons Park, is a popular, large conservation park located in Ruskin, Florida, on the beautiful shores of Tampa Bay.

The park is the site every year for the Ruskin Seafood Festival. Now in its 35th year, this annual festival brings together Bay Area vendors and entertainment. It's a significant, family-friendly community event that draws crowds from around the Tampa Bay area. The event is scheduled for **November 15th and 16th**. Check the official Greater SouthShore Chamber of Commerce or Ruskin Seafood Festival websites for the most up-to-date information on exact times and pricing.

The park covers approximately 469 acres, including open land, intertwined waterways, and a significant 200-acre preserved mangrove swamp that serves as a bird and wildlife sanctuary. It features a 700-foot sandy beach along Tampa Bay, known for its gentle waves, making it family-friendly. The park is a haven for wildlife, with birdwatchers often spotting species like the endangered Roseate Spoonbill and the Bald Eagle.

The park offers a wide variety of outdoor recreation opportunities: Camping: It features a popular campground with over 100 sites for RVs, trailers, and tents. Campsites often include water, electric hookups (30-and 50-amp service available), picnic tables, and fire rings. There are also public restrooms, hot showers, and RV dump stations. Camping is typically first-come, first-served. There are boat launches and access points for canoeing and kayaking through the park's canals and waterways. Kayak rentals are available on-site. Fishing: Visitors can enjoy fishing from multiple piers and along the water's edge.

College Football Playoff Selects Tampa to Host 2029 National Championship

Tampa will become the fourth city to host the CFP title game for a second time.



Bryan Adams

Forever the Reckless One: Bryan Adams' Enduring Rock Legacy

The name **Bryan Adams** conjures images of denim-clad, arena-rock anthems, heart-stopping power ballads, and a voice—often described as a 'sandpaper tenor'—that is instantly recognizable. Over more than four decades, the Canadian singer-songwriter has evolved from a young, ambitious artist in Vancouver's rock scene to a globally celebrated musician, photographer, and activist. Yet, his music retains the raw, genuine energy that defined his breakthrough years.

Born in Kingston, Ontario, Bryan Guy Adams's early life was marked by his military family's international moves. He dropped out of high school at 15 and dedicated himself entirely to music. His career truly took off in 1978 when he met songwriter and drummer **Jim Vallance**. This partnership would prove to be one of the most successful songwriting duos in rock history, initially writing for other artists before cementing Adams's solo career.

His first two albums were a solid foundation, but it was the 1983 release of *Cuts Like a Knife* that launched him into the international spotlight. Tracks like the title cut and the breakthrough U.S. Top 10 hit "Straight from the Heart" demonstrated his potent blend of catchy melodies and gritty rock sensibility.

The year 1984 brought the album that defined a generation of rock music: **Reckless**. It was a global smash, selling over 12 million copies worldwide and yielding a string of iconic hits that remain radio staples today:

- "Run to You"
- "Somebody"
- "Heaven" (his first U.S. No. 1 single)
- "Summer of '69" (a quintessential nostalgic anthem)
- "It's Only Love" (a Grammy-nominated duet with Tina Turner)


Reckless solidified Adams's status as a **heartland rock** powerhouse, bridging hard rock and accessible pop-rock with a sincere, earnest delivery.

While known for his driving rock tunes, Adams demonstrated a mastery of the power ballad, which would dominate his chart performance in the early 1990s. The 1991 blockbuster hit "(Everything I Do) I Do It for You," from the film *Robin Hood:* Prince of Thieves, became one of the best-selling singles of all time, holding the record for the most consecutive weeks at No. 1 on the UK charts.

He followed this success with other massive movie ballads like "All for Love" (with Rod Stewart and Sting for *The Three Musketeers*) and the flamenco-tinged "Have You Ever Really Loved a Woman?" for *Don Juan DeMarco*.

These hits, showcasing his ability to craft deeply emotional, commercially resonant songs, earned him a Grammy Award and multiple Academy Award nominations.





Beyond the stage, Adams has carved out an equally respected career as a **photographer**. His work, often featured in major fashion magazines and advertising campaigns, has been displayed in galleries worldwide. Notably, his book *Wounded* and his work for the Queen of England's Golden Jubilee portrait exemplify his talent behind the lens. He's also a committed **social activist**, using his platform for various humanitarian and charitable causes.

Adams continues to record and tour relentlessly, proving that his rock-and-roll spirit is far from faded. His 2022 album, **So Happy It Hurts**, earned him a Grammy nomination, and he's actively supporting his latest studio effort, **Roll with the Punches** (2025). The album showcases his continued dedication to his blues and rock roots, often performing new tracks alongside his classics on his current tours, demonstrating his desire to both honor his legacy and continue creating.

From his signature denim look to his powerful, gravelly voice, Bryan Adams remains an enduring rock icon, consistently delivering music that connects with fans across generations. He's the restless rocker who found global success by singing straight

Tampa Bay Rowdies

As the 2026 FIFA Men's World Cup nears, the Tampa Bay Rowdies are poised to potentially play a part in the world's largest sporting tournament when it returns to the United States next summer. Waters Sportsplex, the Rowdies' primary training facility, has been added to FIFA's Base Camp brochure, featuring a list of potential base camp locations for teams participating in next year's tournament. Each participating national federation will use the brochure to choose where their team will train during the group stage of the tournament.

"We are honored to be featured in the FIFA World Cup Host Training Site brochure," said Rowdies President Ryan Helfrick. "Having hosted numerous top-tier soccer clubs from around the world over the years, this recognition is another testament to the hard work of our grounds and operations staff, and the world-class quality of our training facility. Getting the chance to host a national team for the world's most prestigious tournament would be a privilege and a tremendous opportunity to showcase our community on an international stage."

The Rowdies 14,600-square-foot complex features two natural grass fields, one FIFA-approved artificial turf field, and offers privacy and convenience with proximity to Tampa International Airport. Since taking over and renovating the complex in 2022, the Rowdies have welcomed teams from Major League Soccer, the National Women's Soccer League, the Premier League, and other top international clubs for preseason preparations and training ahead of major competitions. This past summer, the Rowdies proudly hosted SL Benfica throughout the Portuguese powerhouse's run in the FIFA Club World Cup.

National Teams will submit their final selections for base camp locations following the Final Draw for FIFA World Cup 2026, which is set to take place on December 5 at the Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C. That draw will determine the geographic zones that National Teams will be placed in for the group stage, which will influence their final decisions for a base camp. Final base camp selections are expected to be revealed to the public in early 2026.

With the Government shutdown, many questions are circulating about how it will affect you. If you get medical services from the Veterans' Administration, you still have access to those services. Here is a breakdown of what is and isn't affected by the shutdown. If you are a VA employee, at the bottom are some helpful links on unemployment insurance, sample letters you can send to your creditors and mortgage lender, and information about the furlough itself.

Not impacted by the shutdown:

- VA Medical Centers, Outpatient Clinics, and Vet Centers will be open as usual and providing all services.
- VA benefits will continue to be processed and delivered, including compensation, pension, education, and housing benefits.
- Burials will continue at VA national cemeteries. Applications for headstones, markers, and burial benefits processing will continue.
- The Board of Veterans' Appeals will continue decisions on Veterans' cases.

Call Centers:

- VA's primary call center (<u>1-800-MyVA411</u>) and the Veterans Crisis Line (Dial <u>988</u>, Press 1) will remain open 24/7.
- The VA Benefit Hotline (1-800-827-1000) will be available Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. ET.
- The National Cemetery Scheduling Office (1-800-535-1117) (TTY:711)) will be available Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. ET, and Saturday, 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. ET, to schedule burials.
- Suicide prevention programs, homelessness services, and caregiver support will continue.

Impacted during the shutdown

- VA will cease providing transition program assistance and career counseling.
- Call Centers: VA's GI Bill (1-888-GIBILL-1) hotline and Memorial Products Applicant Assistance (1-800-697-6947) unit will be closed.
- VA benefits regional offices will be closed.
- Public Affairs and unfunded outreach to Veterans will cease, including social media, VetResources emails, and responses to press inquiries.
- No grounds maintenance or placement of permanent headstones at VA cemeteries.
- Applications for pre-need burial at VA cemeteries will not be processed.
- No printing of new Presidential Memorial Certificates.
- No outreach to state, county, tribal, municipal, faith-based, and community-based partners by VA Central Office.

Beyond the Pirate Ship:

How the Buccaneers

Are Charting a New Course



The Tampa Bay Buccaneers are no strangers to turning the page. From the hapless days of the early years to the vaunted defensive titans of the 2002 Super Bowl, and most recently, the fleeting dynasty built by the arrival of a certain legendary quarterback, this franchise's history is a rollercoaster of dramatic highs and lows.

Now, as they celebrate their 50th season, the Buccaneers are charting a course that is both respectful of their past and aggressively focused on the future. The era of a superstar safety net is over; the new mission is to prove that the core of this team—its homegrown talent and renewed belief—is what truly defines the NFC South's reigning champion.

The foundation of Tampa Bay's current success rests on two figures: General Manager Jason Licht and quarterback **Baker Mayfield**. Licht's offseason strategy was masterfully executed. Instead of chasing splashy, outside free agents, the focus was on retention. Locking up cornerstone players like a rejuvenated Mayfield and securing the continued presence of perennial 1,000-yard receiver **Mike Evans** ensured the offensive identity remained intact. This stability is the most potent weapon in a transitional NFC South.

Mayfield, who quieted critics with a career-reviving 2024 campaign, enters 2025 as the undisputed leader. His command of the offense, coupled with the system staying essentially the same under new play-caller Josh Grizzard, points to continued high-level production.

A significant first-round investment in Ohio State, wide receiver Emeka Egbuka, highlighted the 2025 NFL Draft. Egbuka is an immediate, dynamic threat who adds another dimension to an already potent air attack and profiles as a perfect successor or complement to Godwin.

Crucially, the running game has a new look. While veteran **Racheed White** remains a key pass-catching back, the emergence of second-year back **Bucky Irving** promises a more dynamic rushing attack. Irving, who posted over 1,100 yards in his debut year, looks poised for an even more prominent role, creating the explosive balance the offense needs.

For Head Coach Todd Bowles, the defense must revert to the menacing standard set years ago. The biggest splash of the offseason was the signing of veteran edge rusher **Haason Reddick**. This proven sack artist immediately boosts the pass-rush unit alongside young star **Yaya Diaby**. This pairing is crucial for creating the pressure that Bowles' scheme demands.

The defense remains anchored by the immovable object that is nose tackle **Vita Vea** and the ageless wonder, linebacker **Lavonte David**, who continues to lead the unit with intensity and intelligence. The back end of the defense also received heavy investment in the draft with two promising cornerbacks, signaling a commitment to generating more turnovers. The unit, which was average last season, is now retooled to be an elite, ball-hawking force.



As the Buccaneers raise the flags for their 50th anniversary, the atmosphere at Raymond James Stadium promises to be electric. The team is not just celebrating two Super Bowl trophies; they are celebrating a resilient fan base that endured the creamsicle-and-loss years and emerged to celebrate two glorious championships.

The 2025 season is not about recapturing a past era, but about solidifying a future built on smart personnel moves, homegrown talent, and the grit that Tampa Bay football has always required. The Buccaneers are favored to win the NFC South again, and with a retooled defense and a stable, high-powered offense, the cannon on the pirate ship is ready to fire far into January. The new course is set, and it points directly toward contention.

- Tampa Bay Veterans Parade
 - •Date: Saturday, November 8, 2025
 - •**Time:** The parade starts around 10:00 a.m. (Roads on the route, including Hanley Road, close earlier).
 - •Location: Town 'n Country area of Tampa (The parade typically starts near Hanley Road and Barry Avenue).
 - •Details: This is one of the largest Veterans Day parades in Florida, featuring over 60 units, marching bands, military vehicles, and a large turnout from the community to salute veterans.

James A. Haley Veterans' Hospital Veterans Day Parade

- •Date: Saturday, November 8, 2025
- •Time: Ceremony begins at 9:00 a.m., parade starts at 9:30 a.m.

A significant part of the Tampa Bay Veterans Day experience is the hospitality shown by local businesses. While official 2025 announcements are still far out, historically, you can expect:

- Free Admission: The Florida Aquarium and Busch Gardens Tampa Bay have historically offered free or heavily discounted admission to veterans and active military members (sometimes for a limited window of time).
- Dining: Numerous local and national restaurant chains offer free meals or special discounts for veterans on November 11th.
- Cruises: Yacht Starship has offered free dinner or brunch cruises for veterans and active military on the holiday weekend.

Recommendation: For the most current details on times and locations, especially for deals, check the official websites for the City of Tampa, Hillsborough County Veterans Affairs, and major Tampa Bay attractions in **late October/early November 2025**.
