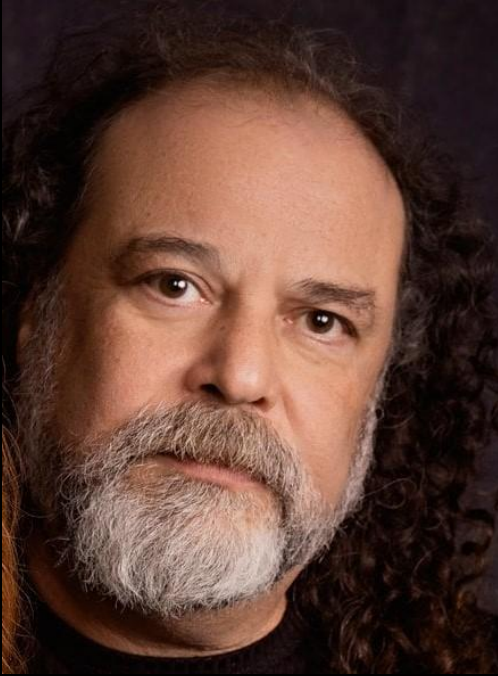

Saddle and Soil: The Grit and Glory of Puerto Plata's Off-Road Adventures



Puerto Plata Country Club

While the Atlantic coast offers turquoise waters, the true heart of Puerto Plata beats in the red clay of its backcountry. Here, the "Country Club" isn't a clubhouse—it's a network of mountain trails, river crossings, and tropical canopies. For those looking to swap the polo shirt for a bandana, the horseback-and-buggy experience is the ultimate initiation into Dominican life.

The Horseback Journey: Back to the Roots

The Dominican Republic has a deep-seated *vaquero* (cowboy) culture, and nowhere is this more evident than in the hills surrounding Puerto Plata. This isn't your standard "nose-to-tail" trail ride.

- **The Terrain:** You'll navigate narrow mountain passes where the horses—sturdy, sure-footed Criollo breeds—effortlessly climb toward views of the Isabel de Torres peak.
- **The Experience:** The rides typically wind through local fruit plantations. It's common to stop mid-trail to crack open a fresh cocoa pod or taste coffee beans straight from the bush.
- **The Connection:** There is a meditative quality to the rhythm of the hooves against the soft earth, right up until you reach the riverbeds, where the horses love to splash through the cooling mountain water.

The Buggy Blast: The Art of Getting Dirty

If the horseback riding is the soul of the island, the 4x4 buggies are the adrenaline. This is where the term "Mud" becomes a badge of honor.

- **The Machine:** These open-air, heavy-duty "muck-monsters" are designed for one thing: conquering the terrain. They are loud, fast, and completely indifferent to rain or shine.
- **The "Mud Factor":** In Puerto Plata, if you return to your hotel with a clean shirt, you didn't do it right. The trails are famously riddled with "chocolate pools"—deep puddles of thick, red Dominican clay. Hitting these at speed sends a geyser of mud over the roll bars, coating everyone in the vehicle.
- **The Pit Stops:** Most buggy routes take you through the "real" DR—past colorful *colmados* (local grocery stores) where kids wave as you roar by and ending at secluded freshwater springs or hidden beaches like Bergantín to wash off the first layer of grit.

Why These Two Pair Perfectly

Most "Country Club" adventure packages in 2026 offer a **Combo Tour**, and for good reason. The horseback riding provides the quiet, scenic intimacy of the Dominican forest, while the buggies provide the high-octane release. It's a contrast of speeds: the slow trot through the mahogany trees followed by the roar of an engine through a canyon.

Pro-Tips for the Puerto Plata Dirt:

The "Throwaway" Wardrobe: Do not wear anything you love. The red clay of Puerto Plata is notorious for its "permanent" staining power. Think of it as a souvenir you can't wash out.

Bandanas & Goggles: The dust is real. A bandana isn't just a fashion choice; it's your air filter.

The Post-Ride Dip: Many of these trails lead to the **Damajagua Waterfalls** or local rivers. There is no feeling quite like jumping into a 70°F (21°C) mountain pool while still covered in trail dust.

Mr. & Mrs. Easter Bunny (Magic Kingdom): They are meeting guests daily through **Easter Sunday** at the **Enchanted Glade Gazebo** in Liberty Square (tucked behind *Ye Olde Christmas Shoppe*).

Times: Intermittently from **9:00 AM – 4:30 PM**.

Note: They don't sign autographs, but they do hand out a special 2026-themed autograph card.

Easter Procession (Magic Kingdom): Keep an eye out for the **Easter Pre-Parade** that typically runs just before the *Festival of Fantasy* parade on Sunday. It features the Azalea Belles, the Easter Bunnies, and springtime floats.

🥚 Scavenger Hunts & Displays

EPCOT Egg-stravaganza: This popular hunt is active right now. You can purchase a map for **\$9.99** at shops like *Creations* or *World Traveler*. Find the large Disney-character eggs hidden around World Showcase to earn a collectible plastic egg prize.

Grand Floridian Chocolate Eggs: The lobby is currently hosting the famous **Easter Egg Cottage** and display. These are massive, hand-carved chocolate eggs created by the pastry team. Similar (though smaller) displays can be found at **Disney's Contemporary Resort** and **Disney's Yacht & Beach Club Resorts**.

Swan & Dolphin Beach Hunt: On **Easter Sunday at 12:00 PM**, the Swan & Dolphin resorts are hosting a massive beach egg hunt with over **16,000 eggs**, including "Golden Eggs" with bigger prizes.

Steakhouse 71 (Contemporary): Offering a special holiday brunch.

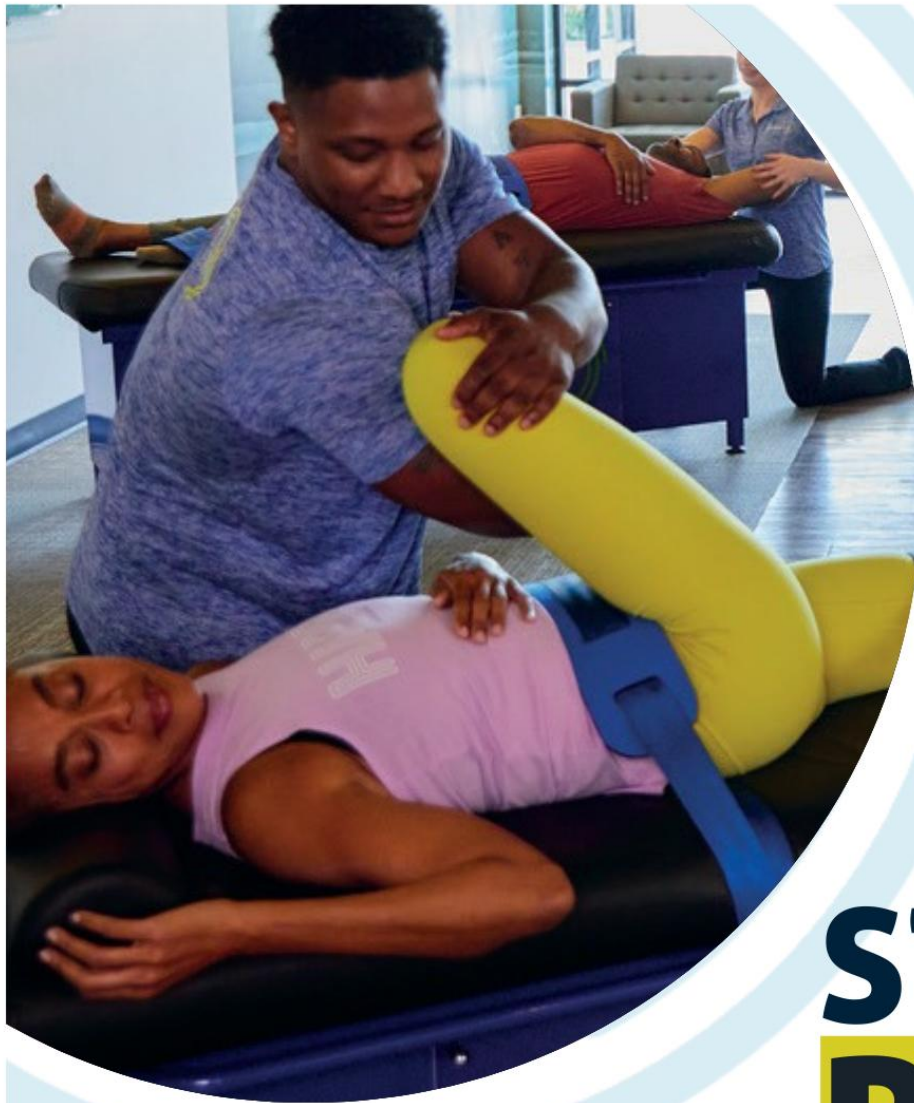

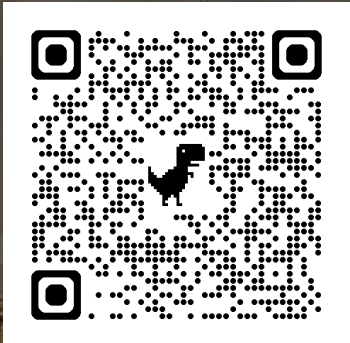

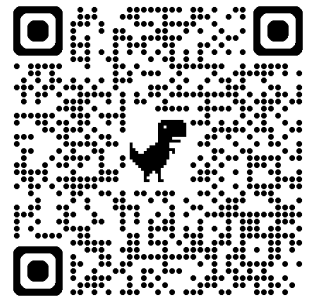

This month, we're getting a treat in Tampa. We'll have the world-famous Old Time Sailors, and I was lucky enough to sit down with Captain Nick for an interview before they arrived. They will be in Tampa on April 23rd at the Tampa Orpheum to kick off their tour. They usually land in one country and do a lot of gigs there, right? So, now we're going to focus a lot on the U.S., since it's such a big country. They'll start in the southern states first. "You know, we're going to be playing in Idaho and several other places, but we prefer warm weather, right? So, we're going to concentrate on staying in the southern states because of that."

Well, the best way to explain who we are is to compare ourselves to Broadway. You know, when most people think of Broadway, they imagine a show that's highly rehearsed. Unlike a music band, Broadway shows are meticulously prepared, and they're incredible to watch. Everything seems to fall perfectly into place, and it's so precise. On the other hand, music bands are often more spontaneous. They don't rehearse as much, which makes their connection with the audience feel rawer and more genuine. It's not a religion or a sect, but it's more like a friendship—an honest connection built with fans. We love touring and doing this because it gives us the chance to meet new communities, new folks, and make new friends along the way. That's the real value for us. We also support charity events when we can. We combine these elements—lots of rehearsals, costumes, props, and decor—into our shows. When you see us perform, many say it sounds like we're playing with a back track, but we're not. We rehearse about 40 hours a week, and the result is a great show. Unlike a Broadway production, we also meet and greet everyone after the show.

We have fans, you know, and we tour the human side of the band. The music part is still there, and I think the best part of the OTS is that it never gets old, never. Because it doesn't depend on just one person, like me, right? I used to play all the time. I don't play as much anymore. Mostly, I play with the guys in Florida, and I'm going to be playing a lot because I love the place. But aside from that, I don't usually play much. And yet it never gets old because new people keep joining in. So, you're never going to see the OTS getting old over time. It's always going to be fresh because there's always a new crew eager to do this.

That's why we have our music camp experience. We hold music camps in Latin America, and we're setting one up in Florida, too. We give people who've never had a chance to tour and play professionally the opportunity to learn with us, reach that level, and then tour with us. That's the plan.

Our band can have up to 30 instruments that they play live. Overall, there are 18 to 20 of us, and we all play more than one instrument. We're plugged in, but we're also unplugged. We use a completely wireless setup, you know. We move around, just like a Broadway show. We go into the audience, you know. When you come to see us, even in a theater, at some point, you'll see us coming out of the stairs or just walking around the theater as much as possible. Some places don't allow it for insurance reasons, so we can't do safety stuff there. In most places, we do. Every song is performed out there with the crowd, with people dancing along; that's the whole point. It's an immersive experience.

It's going, going into the crowd, you know, just leaving the stage. That's why there are so many of us. At least half of us stay on stage to make sure we get the sound right, you know. Because when you go out to the crowd, you never know what might happen—like if wireless equipment turns off or if there's feedback—so the sound guy might turn you off. So, half of us stay on stage, the other half goes into the crowd, and we get everyone dancing or doing something. We also have lots of games and choreographies. We ask people to follow us so we can connect with them, much like the band Baby Metal, with all their choreographed hand moves. Yeah, we try to learn as much as we can about interacting with our fans and making sure they have a great time. Every song we perform is a full song; we don't have any fillers. We focus a lot on making it fun.

Well, one of the things we have is our newspaper program. It's called Sunday Sailor. It includes all the songs so that people can sing along, as well as dancing instructions. So, right away, people say, 'Yeah, yeah.' It also features games and maritime trivia, like trivia about us. People love it. It's about 70 pages overall in each new edition. We're also launching it as a real newspaper, too. There's a fan edition for the shows, and a real newspaper focused on the music industry for folks who want to buy or read it. To get everyone involved beyond the newspaper, we also tell them what to do while we're playing. Since we help more than one singer, with five or six at a time, at least one of them will be calling out the steps, saying things like, 'Okay, people are never going to do this,' or similar.

I've been driving a lot, traveling extensively, meeting many people, yeah, and just doing the weirdest stuff I can think of, like trying to get us to perform at those off-road mud parks, for example. It gets really wild. We love the experience of trying new things, you know. If we get booked for a big festival, we're happy because we've done it many times before and would gladly do it again. But we also do a lot of care home visits, which is one of our favorite activities—making senior people happy, you know. It's a great experience. They really enjoy it, and it's amazing how much they get into it. That's honestly the best experience for us. Of course, we're also trying to get the band out there, you know, not necessarily to be famous. We're quite popular already, honestly, but just to get more and different gigs. Maybe even a gig aboard a battleship, which we're really excited about. That's awesome.

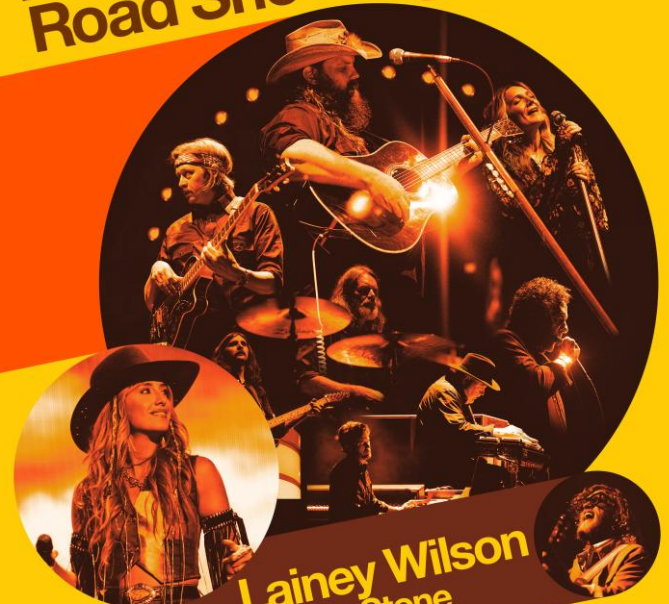

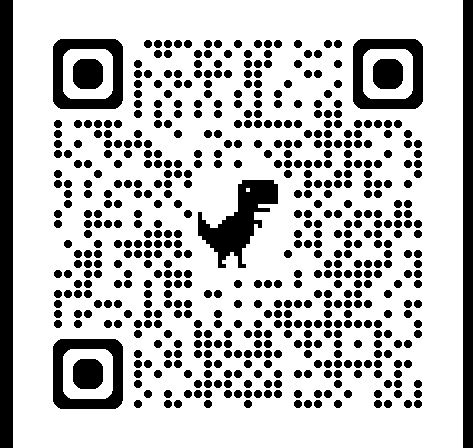

The Tampa Bay Rays are off to an uneven start to the 2026 season, but there are already signs that this group has the pieces—and the chemistry—to settle in quickly.

Tampa Bay opened with a challenging series against the St. Louis Cardinals, dropping two of three. While the results weren't ideal, the games were competitive, and the roster showed flashes of the depth and versatility the organization is known for. The Rays bounced back in their next series, earning their first win of the season against the Milwaukee Brewers—a small but important step in building early momentum.

Even with the inconsistent results, what stands out most is the clubhouse dynamic. This is a group that appears to be clicking early. There's a noticeable level of trust and communication on the field, particularly with players stepping into multiple roles. That kind of chemistry doesn't always show up in the box score right away, but over a long season, it often becomes the difference between a team that hovers around .500 and one that finds its rhythm.

Managerial flexibility is already playing a role. Players are moving around the diamond, filling gaps, and contributing in different ways depending on matchups. It's a hallmark of Rays baseball, and early indications suggest this roster is buying in.

There's also added motivation this season, as the team prepares for a meaningful return home. After spending last year at George M. Steinbrenner Field due to damage caused by Hurricane Milton, the Rays are set to return to Tropicana Field. That return carries both emotional and competitive significance for the organization and its fan base.

The Home Opener is scheduled for Monday, April 6, when the Rays welcome the Chicago Cubs. It marks more than just the first home game—it's a symbolic reset. Playing back at Tropicana Field restores a sense of normalcy and gives the team a familiar environment to build on as the season unfolds.

If the early chemistry holds and the lineup continues to find its footing, the Rays are positioned to turn this uneven start into something much more consistent. There's a long road ahead, but the foundation looks solid—and that's exactly what you want to see in the first stretch of the season.

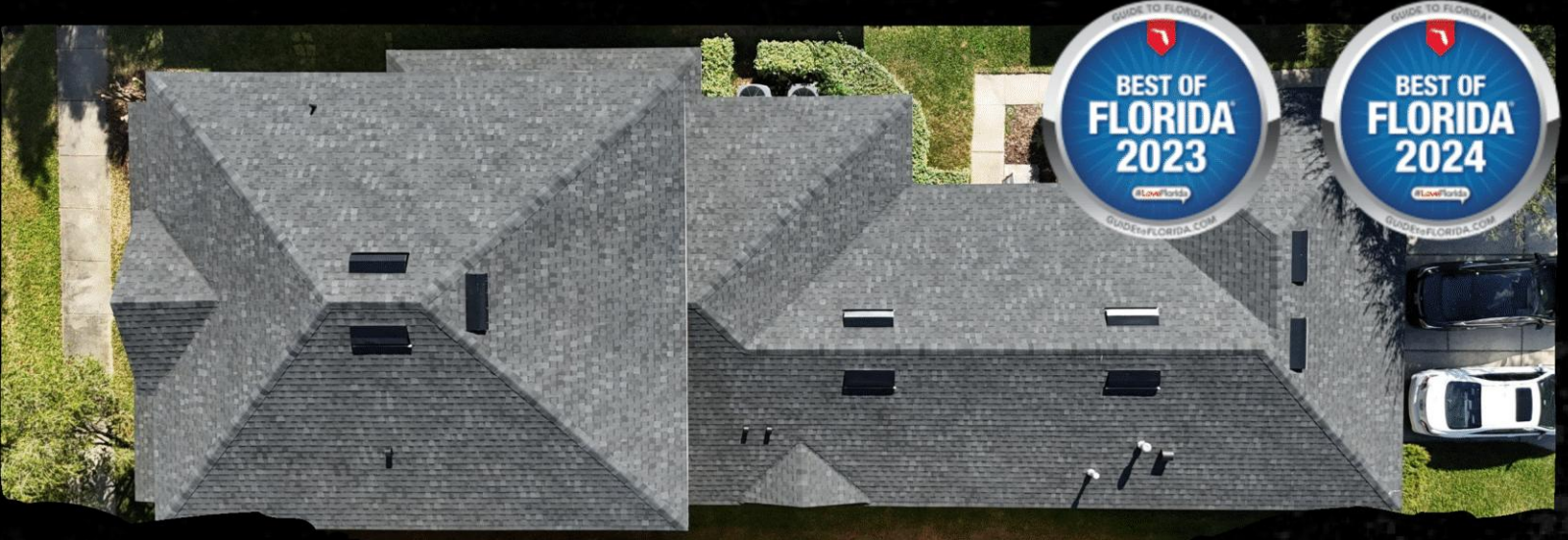

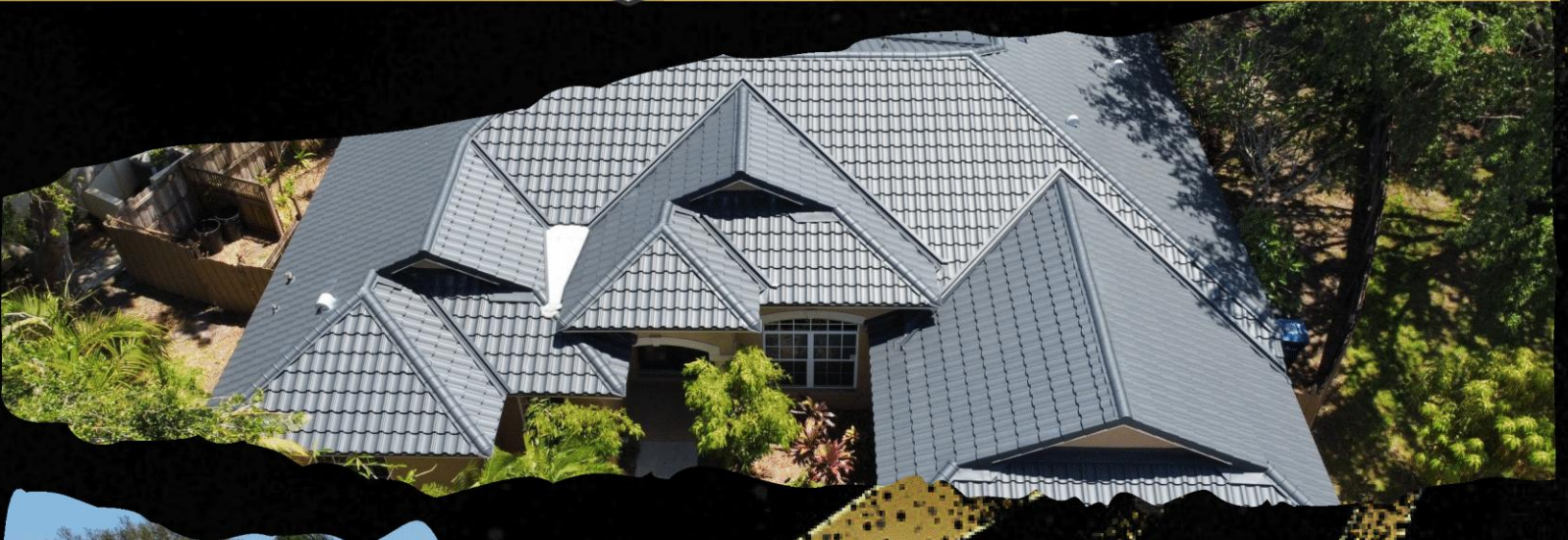
